What's New at the Heath Brook:

This year brings with it tremendous new opportunities for learning in the form of technology! I'm happy to share that the Heath Brook School has acquired an additional 5 iPads per classroom for a total of 11, along with new charging cabinets. The ipads will continue to be utilized during small/whole group instruction to support deeper learning in all content areas. Teachers will also have access to 2 laptop carts and 2 iPad carts that house a full class set for student use. In addition, we also have 2 Clear Touch Screens that are being piloted at the elementary level in place of Smart Boards and projectors.

Our building has also undergone some capital improvements! The Heath Brook School received a fresh coat of paint, in addition to several maintenance updates inside. We have developed some beautiful spaces to enjoy in the form of a student-created Rock Garden at the front entrance, as well as bench seating by the cafeteria door. Please check our new retaining wall and flower beds in the front of the building as well!

Home-School Communication:

Morning Drop Off Procedures:

Each year, we reflect on our drop-off and pick-up procedures to make sure that we have systems in place that allow students to get to school safely and efficiently. Please click **here** for a helpful visual map that outlines this year's drop off procedures. We gently remind families of the following routine:

• Elementary School Families -

- Drop off begins at 8:25 am. Staff members are not on duty to monitor students prior to that time
- Enter into the parking lot (far left) and remain in the single file vehicle drop-off line
- Wait for staff members on duty to signal that it is time for your student to exit the vehicle
- Safely exit the parking lot in a single line

• Please do not park in the lot during morning drop off

• Extended Day Preschool Families -

- Drop off begins at 8:00 and continues until 8:20 am
- Enter into the front "bus" loop in a single file vehicle line
- Wait for Extended Day Preschool staff members to signal that it is time for you to assist your child in exiting the vehicle
- Safely exit the parking lot in a single line

Afternoon Pick Up Procedures:

Tewksbury Public Schools provide bus transportation to all students. We encourage families to utilize this resource, as it is an exciting part of our students' school experience. However, if you choose to pick up your child in the afternoon, we kindly ask that you print/fill out the following dismissal form and send it to school with your child on the first day of school. We will have paper copies available as well.
