Treasurer's Report:

Treasurer's report was presented and approved. The check for Erin Murphy was delivered. A brick for the new High School was purchased in the fall from the class of 2012 at a reduced rate of \$37.50. We have funds to cover 8 - \$500 scholarships at year end.

Action Items:

Eileen Osborne told the PAC that a tour for PAC members would be planned for the end of Feb./begins March based on work progress in the new building.

Items for Purchase: The Life Skills class requested a vacum. Eileen will look into exactly what is needed and whether this is a school or PAC expense. PAC authorized \$200 to spend for the vacuum if it does not fall under school item budget.

Principal's Report/Discussion:

Eileen Osborne reported that they are finalizing bids for technology and furnishings. Current desks and furnishings will be re-used where possible.

IPAD Pilot program started this week. They are working out the bugs for the wireless situation for the internet. The first Literacy Committee will be held on Jan. 31st. More information to follow.

The new High School building will be ready in August and is meeting the construction deadline.

The internet is working at an acceptable level at this time.

DJ – same price as last year. Diane needs baskets and items to raffle. She will communicate via email about what is needed. Loretta will get the golf course certificate to raffle again.
