Introductions

Co-chair Diane Dunlevy and Maura Rauseo opened the meeting at 7:00 P.M..

Minutes

March 29th and April 26th minutes were submitted, reviewed and accepted.

Treasurer's Report

Treasurer's report was submitted reviewed and accepted. Previous Art department request for \$367.12 Art literary magazine and a DVD were funded using \$200 Misc. School supply budget and \$167.12 funds from the general budget.

Principal's Report

Recently installed air conditioners were appreciated and librarian Mary Elderinghoff sent a thank you note. Raptor software receipt was mistakenly paid for using the principal's account. The PAC cannot fund the principal's budget directly so the suggestion was to purchase an equivalent item similar to the cost of the Raptorware. Vice Principal Osborne suggested that the PAC purchase a smart board to equate the costs. The smart board will be raffled for the teacher room location. The PAC requested that the smart board placement be specified. The administration's policy is that a raffle be done.

Apple computer lab is being used for the media video lab. 18 computers are used. This year was a ramping up year with the instructor needing instruction prior to teaching the class.

The civic and social expectations addition to the report cards is a NEASC requirement to report out civic and social rubrics to assess the progress of the child's community in the classroom.

A motion was made to allocate \$200 to attend the Doctor McGrath to represent the TMHS PAC at the retirement ceremony. All approved.
