Treasurer's Report

Treasurer's report was submitted reviewed and accepted with minor corrections. Available funds as of 11/29 are \$12,183.13. Allocated funds are \$3,000 for scholarships, \$1,600 per class council, \$3,000 for All Night Long Committee and \$272.30 paid out for last year's custodian workers. Approximately \$4,000 left of unallocated funds.

Principal's Report

Construction traffic is planned to cease during school morning drop off and dismissal. Breakfast is currently being offered in the morning before school through the cafeteria. The PAC requested that the daily bulletin be updated by the TMHS staff to include all of the latest information for distribution. An MCAS informational night at the Wynn is being held at 6 PM in the library. MCAS sample questions and scoring and tips on how to help your child prepare for the test will be discussed. Parent conferences are being held on 11/30/2010, 11-2 PM..

Discussion took place about the non-school sponsored powder puff football game and a request was made to have the event be school sponsored held with supervision. No decisions were made at this time. Discussion took place about pep rally release and the possibility of police patrol. No decisions were made at this time.

Teacher's Request

Dr. Nicole Saad requested \$250.00 for experiments in the newly formed chemistry club. Interest and participation is good for this club. All voted and all were in favor.

Enrichment

\$1,500 remains in the enrichment fund for the year.

Applefest

Approximately \$7,500 was raised during the Applefest. 40% of Table Space Rental and Cafeteria Profits after expenses will be allocated to the All Night Long Committee.

132 tickets sold. Maura Rauseo took pictures of all the tables. Raffle prizes were very well received. \$1310 profits which results in \$327 per class. A suggestion was made to round up the dollar amounts to \$400.00 per class council.

Teacher Requests

One teacher request was made for Eyes on Owls in house program which would benefit 53 children. Teacher Jamie Pringle is asking for \$200 out of the \$450 required for the program. The PAC discussed finding out if the program could benefit more children. A motion was made to allocate \$200 towards the in house program with a follow on request to have the program offered to more students.
