## **Treasurer's Report**

## **Principal's Report/Discussion**

The School Committee policy about student activity accounts was discussed. Two accounts are kept: 1) checking – which checks are written from and savings. The accounts are audited periodically. Requests under \$4,000.00 are made through Vice Principal Eileen Osborne and forwarded to the Town Hall for approval. Lisa Kuegler made the recommendation to streamline this process by scanning receipts and emailing items to be approved.

Eileen sent out a list to all advisors about accounts and remaining balances. After 6 months, money has to be cleared out of the graduating class account and gets set aside in a savings for a 5<sup>th</sup> year reunion fund. A full accounting is kept.

There will be no Junior Prom in 2012; it will remain a Junior Semi-formal.

#### **Enrichment**

There is \$3,000.00 budgeted for Enrichment. Mr. Belistri has a contact for a presentation about Troubled Youth that he is working on.

### **Student Requests**

A student request was made by Nicole Dunlevy to make a donation to help sponsor a child at Heart House for community service. The PAC voted in favor to give \$75.00 per child to 2 school aged children within the Tewksbury school district to support this effort. Receipts for items purchased will be supplied by Diane Dunlevy.

## **Meeting Discussion**

PAC had to do a budget for the Superintendent for proposed donations for the year need to be approved and accepted by the school committee.
