New England and Massachusetts' History

Students will be able to:

- Identify the Wamponoags, their leaders, and describe their way of life
- Identify who the Pilgrims were, explain why they left Europe, and describe the differences between the Puritans and the Pilgrims

The American Revolution

Students will be able to:

- Explain the important political, economic, and military developments leading to and during the war
- Identify the following key American documents: Declaration of Independence, Constitution, and Bill of Rights
- Explain the meaning of the stars and stripes in the American flag, and describe the official procedures for the care and display of the flag
- Read a biography about a person from Massachusetts and summarize the person's life and achievements
