- ★ Each poster should be no larger than 16x20 inches. Paper submissions only! (However, if you create a poster digitally, and then print it out, that is okay)
- ★ Posters must be submitted to the Tewksbury Public Library (300 Chandler Street, Tewksbury, MA 01876) by March 31st, 2020. Your name, grade and telephone number must be printed legibly on the back of your piece.
- ★ All ages welcome, and there will be a prize for each age group. Age Groups:preschool, Grades k-5, Grades 6-12, Adult

All posters will be displayed around Tewksbury Public Library throughout the month of April, Autism Acceptance Month! The winners of the contest will be announced in May.
