




Dress Up DAYS



Monday, March 2nd: Heath Brook- "The Lorax" Wear a Mustache Day! "No dress up for Trahan students




Tuesday, March 3rd: "Fox in Socks" Crazy Sock Day

Thursday, March 5th: "The Cat in the Hat" Crazy Hat Day


