<u>Introductions and Minutes</u>: Co-chairs Diane Dunlevy and Maura Rauseo opened the meeting at 7:10 PM. February 28, 2012 minutes were presented, a minor change was made and minutes were accepted. Mr. Paul Hibner, member of Friends of Tewksbury Community Athletics Complex was introduced.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer's report was presented and approved.

<u>Principal's Report:</u> Inventory of items in school has been taken. A 'Move-coordinator' is helping teachers & administrators with upcoming move into new school. Semester 1, items are currently being boxed and marked for the move. Bids for the move are underway. A technology group is meeting to discuss technology needs in new school.

Meeting Discussion:

Athletic Complex: Mr. Hibner, presented information on the proposed Athletic complex. Project needs approximately 1.96 million dollars. The estimate per average house for taxes is expected to be \$20/year for 10 years. Project will include turf field, stadium seats, lights, scoreboard, sound system, nets and goals and five tennis courts. Thus far \$50,000 has been raised with expectations of \$8,000 per year from TDBank program. A vote on this complex will take place on April 14, 2012.

PAC By-Laws: PAC by-laws that were modified at last meeting and reviewed again and approved.

Applefest: A new registration form is being drafted. Linda Poli suggested many ideas for celebrating the 25th anniversary of the craft fair. She would like to get some sub-committees together to assist with the many aspects. A meeting was scheduled April 24, 2012 at 7:00pm in the TMHS library.
