Dear Students and Parents/Guardians:

Even though the weather still feels like summer, the beginning of the 2017-2018 School Year is right around the corner. This fall brings exciting academic opportunities for our students and faculty! This year we will be offering Advanced Placement Art History and an elective course on Hispanic Culture for the first time! We also have two faculty committees who will be proposing this fall the creation of two programs for students. One of the programs is a Senior Project for all seniors to participate in during fourth quarter of senior year. Our goal is to pilot this program in the Spring of 2018! As we finalize the program, we will send out details to both seniors and parents. We will also be proposing a Global Competency Diploma program starting with the Class of 2021. This will be a program where students will apply during their sophomore year so that they can fulfill all of the requirements in order to earn the additional diploma at graduation. Later this fall we will send out more specific information about the requirements and the process to both students and parents. As part of our work around social emotional learning and building an inclusive school community our students will be participating in Challenge Day on October 2nd. The Challenge Day organization is the world leader in building school communities where students and adults feel safe and connected. In our continued efforts to keep all of our students safe and informed about the dangers of alcohol and drug use, we will be having a mandatory pre-prom program for all juniors and their parents in late February or early March. Seniors and their parents must attend this pre-prom program only if they did not attend the program last year as a junior. More details concerning the exact date and time for this event will be sent out this fall. Once again, we are attempting to make the beginning of school process as efficient as possible for you all by putting all of the consent and release forms on Community Pass. We have provided directions for accessing Community Pass and the forms. Similar to last year, I have scheduled the Admin Chats for parents and guardians throughout the course of the year and informal sessions for parents to come and meet with me. The chats will have a content focus. I have asked the department head/lead teacher for each major content area to be at the Admin Chat to answer any questions you might have. I hope that you will be able to attend one of the chats so that we can have the opportunity to hear your thoughts and ideas. I also encourage students to set up an appointment with me or just stop by my office to share an idea or thought.

We are excited to welcome new faculty and staff members to the TMHS family. The common application is the application that most colleges and universities across the nation use for their admission process. The application is all done electronically and becomes available to students on August 1, 2017. Guidance counselors will be available to provide help and advice on the college essay and the common app. Students should have access to their social security number, resume with activities, parents/guardians contact information, parent's occupation and education level in order to complete the application. Friday, September 29th 7:45-8:45 a.m. Senior Parent Breakfast 9-10:00 a.m. Senior Student Assembly Senior parents may come and enjoy breakfast while meeting your student's guidance counselors, college admission representatives, and other members of the TMHS community. Parents will have the opportunity to gain insight into the college application process. A brief presentation on accessing disability supports in the college arena will be made by Susan Woods, Associate Dean of Student Support Services at MCC. Afterwards, students will meet in the auditorium with the admissions representatives for the same informational meeting on the college process.

Wednesday, October 11th 7:40-12:15 p.m. PSAT Exam for all Sophomores and Juniors

It is recommended that all sophomores and juniors participate in the PSAT exam. Junior students who excel at PSAT exam may qualify for the National Scholarship Program. This exam gives our sophomores and juniors practice with the type of questions on the new SAT exam. It also gives the students feedback on their strengths and specifically what Advanced Placement courses they should consider taking.

Thursday, October 5th 6-8:00 p.m. College Financial Aid Presentation

Sophomore and junior parents are invited to attend a very important Financial Aid presentation conducted by MEFA. The recent changes in the FAFSA process and informative tips will assist parents in navigating this process.

This is an exciting evening for the parents of 8th grade students to meet the high school administration and members of the high school administrative team. Department Chairpersons will be available to answer all your curriculum questions.

Critical Forms (Accident and Illness (if requiring update), Consent and Release, Medication (if applicable), Acceptable Use, Photo Release, Student Handbook sign off:

Back to school always means filling out several critical forms so that we can best serve your child. To reduce the amount of paper we send home to you, we have made electronic versions of the forms for you to read and sign using Community Pass. We have included directions for logging into Community Pass and setting up an account. The link to access the forms is https://register.communitypass.net. The tab for the forms is at the bottom of the list. Click on the forms tab to access all forms. Since we use email to communicate with parents primarily we ask that you make sure that your email in Aspen is up to date when you are updating your other information in Aspen. Please make sure your contact information including emergency information is accurate.

Extra-Curricular Activities:

It is important for students to feel connected to their school. When students are connected by being involved in clubs, activities and athletics they are often more successful in the classroom. I challenge all of our students to join at least one club, activity, and/or athletic team at TMHS. Bring your friends along and make many new ones in the process! This year all students participating in athletics or in a club must register at Community Pass. You may also pay the user fee online through Community Pass at https://register.communitypass.net. You can pay with a credit card or using your checking account. Students will not be allowed to try out for a sport or participate in a club until the fee has been paid. You will be able to log in to Community Pass on August 1st to pay. All Tewksbury families have an account with Community Pass. You received an email in April with your username and login. Please see the insert with directions on logging into Community Pass.

Student Parking:

Parking spaces are only for senior and junior students. If you wish to obtain a parking permit (and meet the set requirements), you will be issued a pass. The cost this school year for a parking permit is \$150. All students must first register for a parking permit through Community Pass at https://register.communitypass.net. You can pay the fee with a credit card or using your checking account through Community Pass. You will be able to register and pay as of August 15th. See the insert with directions on logging into Community Pass. After a student has registered for parking on Community Pass the student should report to the TMHS office on Thursday, August 24th with a Xerox copy of their license and a Xerox copy of their registration. Seniors should report from 9-11:00 a.m. and Juniors from 12 noon to 2:00 p.m. to pick up parking pass.
