Minutes

September 27th minutes were submitted, reviewed and accepted.

Treasurer's Report

Treasurer's report was submitted reviewed and accepted with minor corrections. Available funds as of 10/25 are \$3,903.55.

Principal's Report

November 3rd is the date for the launch of an anti-bullying campaign at the Wynn. Training is being held at 6:30 P.M. for the task force with the public meeting at 7 PM. Student Trivia

The tables are coming in slowly. At least 8 people are recommended per table. Alumni are allowed to participate. Student Trivia is being held November 10th at the Elks. The hall will be \$100. Suggested donations are for cans of soda. Donations are coming in. The evening starts at 6 PM. Keith Rauseo is the MC for the event. Police detail is not required with responsible adults in attendance at the Elks. Ovens can be used ovens but used by adults only. A motion was made to allocate \$300 to cover the hall and the prize money and miscellaneous expenses. Voted and all approved. Up to 30 tables can fit in the Elks.

Teacher Requests

One teacher request was made for Eyes on Owls in house program which would benefit 53 children. Teacher Jamie Pringle is asking for \$200 out of the \$450 required for the program. The PAC discussed finding out if the program could benefit more children. A motion was made to allocate \$200 towards the in house program with a follow on request to have the program offered to more students.

Adopt-A-Classroom

Funds the PAC donated two years ago, \$30 per teacher, are being followed up on to ensure that the money is being spent.

Guest Speaker

Superintendent Dr. O'Connor spoke about the number of kids who leave the public school system. He spoke about reinventing the TMHS and showcasing the offerings of the TMHS. A survey is being created to be sent to parents who left the community to assess why the students are leaving.
