Prior to school starting, we invite students accompanied by a parent or caregiver, to visit the Ryan School for a <u>self-guided tour</u> of the building. All incoming 5th graders will receive a Chromebook in their homeroom on the first day of school. These devices are owned by the school district but will be assigned to the students through grade 8. Any damage to the device could result in a cost to the student (up to \$200). Optional insurance can be purchased to cover all damages for \$62. Insurance is free for students on Free and Reduced lunch plans. Please contact Deb Mugford and ask her to send your information to the IT department to get free insurance. We highly recommend purchasing insurance for your student's Chromebook to cover any damages that may occur while the device is being used. This year we will be returning to an A - E day schedule rather than Monday - Friday. The Ryan School hours are 8:10 AM - 2:30 PM with drop off and homeroom beginning at 7:55 AM. \* Students arriving after 8:10 AM are tardy and must be signed into school in the main office by an adult. We will continue to offer free breakfast and lunch to all students.

Student's team and homeroom number will be available on Aspen once the district updates for this school year. \*Please note that team placements are subject to change based on student service delivery and accommodations that are required.
