Prior to school starting, we invite students *accompanied by a parent or caregiver*, to visit the Ryan School for a *self-guided tour* of the building. These tours are scheduled for **Tuesday, August 20**

from 1- 3PM and Wednesday, August 21 at 10AM - 12PM here at the Ryan School (please enter through the main lobby entrance). Please feel free to come in anytime during those hours to look around. *Important note: teachers may be working classrooms, and classrooms will not be open to enter.

The Ryan School's traditional **Parent/Caregiver Open House** is scheduled for **Wednesday**, **September 4, 2024, for Grade 6** parents and guardians from **6 - 8PM**, and **Thursday, September 5 for Grade 5** parents and guardians from **6 - 8PM**. These informative sessions will explain new school procedures, curriculum and assessment overviews, and give parents and guardians time to visit their child's classrooms and meet their teachers.

Parent-Teacher Conferences take place twice a year, and will be held this year on **November 12**, **2024**, **and March 4**, **2025**. Sign up information will become available directly from your child's teacher as the dates get closer. As always, please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher directly if you have any questions or concerns.

This year we will be returning to a traditional Monday - Friday schedule. <u>The Ryan School hours</u> are 8:05 AM - 2:25 PM with drop off and homeroom beginning at 7:50 AM. * Students arriving after 7:50 AM are tardy and must be signed into school in the main office by an adult. We will continue to offer free breakfast and lunch to all students.

Student's team and homeroom number will be available on Aspen once the district updates for this school year, which is expected to the week of August 21st.

Drop off and pick up for students is one way around both the Ryan and Center Schools, and bus routes will be posted on the TPS website near the start of the school year.
