- Writing has heart
- You can hear the authors voice as you read
- Lively engaging topic
- The author invites the audience into his thinking
- The topic is addressed appropriately in relationship to the audience

Word Choice

- Words create a clear picture in reader's mind
- Words are creative, original, and effective
- · Words match topic, audience, and purpose
- Strong verbs and explicit nouns present
- Technical terms are used appropriately and defined when necessary

Sentence Fluency

- Smooth flowing
- Piece is easily picked up and read without practice
- Sentence beginnings are varied
- Varied length of sentences
- Transitions are smooth

- Presentation is neat and appropriate for mode
- Spelling is correct
- Punctuation is correctly used
- Paragraphs are indented appropriately
