

The Frayer Model

The Frayer Model is a graphic organizer used for vocabulary instruction. It consists of a large square divided into four quadrants by a vertical and a horizontal line. In the center of the square is a smaller rounded rectangle labeled "WORD". The four quadrants are labeled as follows:
