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COMMUNITY SERVICES

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We have teamed up with Community Pass to offer online registrations and payments. You will be able to track your account online, make payments each week, and see your balance due. Please register for all Enrichment and Extended Day Programs online at www.tewksbury.k12.ma.us under About, Community Services and then Summer Programs OR go directly to Community Pass at https://register.communitypass.net/TewksburyPublicSchools. After you login hit "Browse Activities and Register" and once registered you can make a payment at that time (for a small convenience fee), or mail in a check separately to Community Services, 139 Pleasant St. Tewksbury, MA 01876. Please be sure to write your child's name, family ID, and what you registered for in the memo section of the check. Please keep in mind, https://registered for the class or extended day until payment is made. Please note: for the Extended Day Program, once you have registered, any changes to your schedule must still be done on a change form that is available at the site your child attends. Do not email the office. Please allow 3-4 business days for changes to show up on your account.

Introduction

4&5 YEAR OLD PROGRAM (For 4 & 5 year olds - must be 4 as of 8/31/18.)

This program will be offered at the **Dewing School (see registration form for times and options), Monday through Friday.** Each week will highlight a theme-based activity including Bugs, Dinosaurs, Western, Gardening, Sports, Beach/Ocean, Pirates, and Camping. We will also be offering field trips **throughout the summer. Please bring a lunch, snack and drinks daily.** Also, please WEAR a bathing suit (2 piece for girls is preferred), bring a towel, and wear sunscreen each day. We suggest you also send along a change of clothes in case of an accident. Student must be toilet trained to attend this program.

SUMMER EXTENDED DAY (For Students entering Grades 1-3)

Tewksbury Public Schools is pleased to announce the continuation of our Full and Half Day Extended Day Summer Program for students entering Grades 1-3 (see registration form for times and options.) We offer your child a full complement of enriching activities in a safe, well-supervised fun-filled environment at the Dewing School. Daily enrichment activities will include arts and crafts, a recreation/game room, outside water/sprinkler activities, playground, computers, and gym. Each Thursday will feature a special activity. One day per week we will travel locally for swimming. Please bring a lunch, snack and drinks daily. However, students may also opt to purchase lunch at the recreation center prepared by Tewksbury Food Services. There will be field trips available for an additional fee to cover the cost of transportation and/or admission charge. Field Trips must be registered online and are first come, first served.

ADVENTURE PROGRAM (For Students entering Grades 4-9)

Tewksbury Public Schools is pleased to announce that the Full and Half Day Extended Day Summer Program for students entering Grades 4-9 will continue at the Wynn Middle School (Gr.4-6) and Livingston Street Rec. Center (Gr.7-9) (see registration form for times and options.) Each day will feature cooperative games, leadership activities, team and adventure sports, computers, gym, and arts and crafts. One day per week we will travel to a local pool for swimming. Please bring a lunch, snack and drinks daily. However, students may also opt to purchase lunch at the recreation center prepared by Tewksbury Food Services. There will be field trips available for an additional fee to cover the cost of transportation and/or admission charge. Field Trips must be registered online and are first, come first served.

GAP WEEK AT THE LIVINGSTON ST. REC CENTER (For Students PK-entering Grade 6)

WEEKLY ENRICHMENT CLASSES

In addition to the Summer Extended Day Programs, Tewksbury Community Services Division of Tewksbury Public Schools is pleased to provide weekly enrichment classes for children. These enrichment classes are in the areas of Creative Arts, Science and Engineering, and Sports. For a complete listing of the classes offered, please refer to pages 6-14. All Classes are held at the Dewing or Wynn Middle School unless otherwise noted. Any exceptions are listed with the course description. Classes will run subject to sufficient enrollment. Once you register and pay for a class you will receive a confirmation email. If a class is cancelled, you will only be notified by email so please check your email regularly.

Summer Program Policies and Procedures

DROP OFF PROGRAM PROCEDURES

Parents/Guardians must provide transportation to all of the Summer Programs and Courses. Children must be walked into the school each morning/afternoon. <u>All parents/guardians must sign-in upon arrival.</u>

PICK UP PROGRAM PROCEDURES

Parents/Guardians must provide transportation home from all of the Summer Programs and Courses. Parents/Guardians must sign-out each day and let the staff know that you and your child are leaving. WHO MAY PICK UP MY CHILD? Only a child's parent/guardian or a person designated IN WRITING by the child's parent/guardian will be allowed to pick up the child. No child will be released to anyone other than a parent/guardian without the signed permission of the parent/guardian. Please be aware that if the staff does not know the person you have designated to pick-up your child, that person will be asked for photo identification.

TRANSPORTATION TO/FROM ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS TO/FROM EXTENDED DAY THERE IS NO TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM ENRICHMENT/EXTENDED DAY THIS SUMMER. IN MOST CASES CLASSES WILL OCCUR AT THE SAME SITES AT THE EXTENDED DAY PROGRAMS. CHILDREN WILL BE WALKED TO AND FROM ENRICHMENT CLASES FROM THEIR EXTENDED DAY PROGRAM.

PICK-UP - LATE FEES

It is important that your child is picked up promptly. Parents/Guardians arriving late will be charged a late fee of \$5.00 for every five (5) minutes they are late after the end of a session. Continual abuse of this pick-up policy may result in exclusion from the program.

EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBERS

Make sure the Summer Program staff knows where to contact you <u>AT ALL TIMES</u> while your child is attending the program. If you are not going to be at your usual number, please let the staff know where they can reach you in the case of an emergency. If you are going to be out of town, let the staff know whom to contact in your place. All parents/guardians are asked to provide the names and phone numbers of at least two <u>local</u> people to call if the parent/guardian cannot be reached. It is your responsibility to complete the accident/illness form online and inform staff of any changes to this information that may occur during the course of the summer.

A deposit of the first week's tuition is required with each child's registration. Registration must be done online and if paying by check separately (instead of paying online) please include your child's name, family ID and program on the memo line of your check. This will assist in processing, and will ensure that your check will be credited to your account. Payments for the Weekly Enrichment Classes should also be made at the time of registration either online or by check. Note: Enrollment in Summer Programs may be restricted due to outstanding Tewksbury Public Schools financial obligations. If you have an outstanding balance please call our office to arrange payment before you register. Also, students with outstanding tuition balances may not be able to participate in field trips unless approved by the Community Services Director.

Late payments: A late fee of \$15.00 may be assessed on any Extended Day tuition paid after the due date. Missing two consecutive payments may result in your child being excluded from the program.

Absences: No refunds will be made for any absences due to illness, family commitments, etc. Two weeks notice must be given for cancellations of days/weeks, otherwise you will be responsible for payment as staff is scheduled 2 weeks ahead and last minute withdrawals will result in over staffing. Please be sure to fill out a change/withdrawal form with the staff for any changes to your schedule. (The billing office does not monitor attendance, therefore changes to billing are only made once the signed change/withdrawal form is forwarded to the billing office by the staff. You must register for Enrichment Classes online and tuition payments for the Weekly Enrichment Classes are to be made at the time of the registration either online or by mailing in a check/money order.)

The tuition is listed with each course description. (There is a 2.9% convenience fee for credit card payments or a \$.40 per transaction fee for ACH payments –payment directly from your checking account.) Checks and money orders should be made payable to "Town of Tewksbury". Cash payments will not be accepted. Note: Convenience fees are non-refundable.

<u>REFUNDS</u>: Tuition is refundable if there is insufficient enrollment and a course is cancelled. Students withdrawing before the first class will be assessed a \$5.00 administrative fee. THERE ARE NO REFUNDS FOR WITH-DRAWING BEYOND THE FIRST CLASS. There are no refunds for any fees paid if you use a credit card or EFT/ACH to make a payment.

Returned Checks: Checks that are returned by your bank for any reason are subject to a \$25.00 returned check fee. A returned check must be replaced by a money order in the amount of the check plus the \$25.00 fee and brought to Town Hall for processing. Failure to resolve this matter within 30 days will result in a status change to "Money Order Only" which means checks will no longer be accepted as forms of payment and you risk not being able to register your child for future programs/classes. Reminder, bounced checks must be resolved at the Town Hall Annex (Treasurer's Office). Payments rejected online are subject to a \$15.00 fee. This fee is charged by Invoice Cloud, not the Tewksbury Public Schools, so it cannot be waived.

Accident/Illness and Consent/Release Forms

It is imperative that we have an updated Accident/Illness Form and Consent/Release Form for each child that is registered in all summer programs. **This information is collected when you register online.** It does not get carried over from the school year information, as each new season you are asked to update all information for safety reasons.

Student Discipline Guidelines

In the case of inappropriate behavior, parents/guardians will be notified verbally and in writing by staff. In the case of repeated infractions, **students will be suspended**. Continued violation of rules will result in expulsion from the program. Also, if any behavior creates an unsafe environment for students and/or staff, the **student will be suspended or expelled immediately from the program**.

Note: We are not responsible for typographical errors.

Payments and Tuition Policies

Payments may be made ONLINE (There is a 2.9% fee for credit card payments or a \$.40 per transaction fee for ACH payments —payment directly from your checking account) or you may pay by check or money order made out to "Town of Tewksbury". Cash payments will not be accepted. Tuition payments for the Dewing 4 & 5 Yr. Old, Dewing 1-3, Wynn, AND Recreation (REC) Programs are to be made on each Thursday prior to the week your child will be attending. Payments can be done ONLINE, given to the Site Director, or mailed in to Community Services, 139 Pleasant St. Tewksbury, MA 01876. Early payments will be gladly accepted. If also paying for field trips, you may write one check but be sure to indicate in the memo section the name of the child, your family ID, which week(s) and field trip(s) the payment is for.

HOW TO REGISTER AND PAY ONLINE

Go to the TPS website at www.tewksburv.k12.ma.us and click on About, Community Services and then Summer Programs. Find the link to do online registrations and payments and click on it. Save this link in your favorites as you will need it in the future. The

direct link is https://register.communitypass.net/TewksburyPublicSchools. You must now log in to your account under Community Pass to access the registration page. If you do not know your login and password please email Maura at

mrauseo@tewksbury.k12.ma.us Do NOT create a new account.

Once logged in click "Browse Activities and Register" and a list of available programs will come up. Choose the program you want (Summer 2018). Once in summer, choose who you are registering and continue on. If more than one person is registering for a class, each individual must be registered. Complete your registration by filling in all necessary information. You will receive an email confirmation once you are registered.

Acceptable forms of payment include: Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Discover

and vour Bank Account.

Please Note: there is a convenience fee for all credit card payments (2.9%) or a fee to pay from your checking acct (\$.40 per transaction). You can also mail in a payment. There are no refunds for fees paid when paying online.

If your child attends our Extended Day Program and you want to sign up for an Enrichment Class, there is a tuition fee for each class in addition to what you pay for Extended Day. A staff member will walk your child to and from the Enrichment Class as long as it is at the same site. Please note: we are not offering any transportation to and from enrichment this summer. Parents are responsible for transportation.
