He reported the School Committee will hear from district principals and directors today about scheduling, collaboration with staff on student specifics as the district continues to negotiate with the Tewksbury Teachers Association (TTA) to provide positive outcomes for our students.

He commented that the Hybrid Model presents challenges for parents. We continue to look at Food Services regarding how to provide meals, staffing, and social distancing eating 6" apart. Transportation is another challenge as we are limited to the students on a bus. We are managing multiple staff leave requests specific to the COVID pandemic. The district is actively looking for substitutes. Due to these challenges the partial day in-person followed by the remaining of the school day in a remote setting is more attainable. The district is setting high expectations and working closely with the TTA specifically with Remote Learning and the Remote Learning Academy.
